TUESDAY, JANUARY 24 AT 6:30PM

This meeting was held at the Fraternal Order of Eagles.

1. Introduction of guests and new members:
 - 33 members, no guests.
2. Secretary's Report:
 - Current membership is at 88 members
 - New members Cheryl R. And Kathy F. were voted on for membership and approved.
3. Treasurer's Report:
 - Balance at the end of the 2022 year was \$11,672.86.
 - Balance as of January 24 was \$12,236.36
4. Old Business:
 - Dave S. briefly talked about the Christmas Party that occurred in December. If you can think of any improvements, please let one of the officers know.
 - Auctions: We encourage you to pick up the coins that you're interested in, inspect them for condition and grade. If you want to bid on it, put a poker chip on the item. Write down the items you won so you have an idea of what to pay. If you sold anything, keep track of the sales.
 - The Coin Club's Raffle License Application was denied by the state. They considered us a "social group" because we do not have a IRS approved letter stating we are non-profit. We will look to do other things to give us additional funding.
 - The Guess the Price of Silver Contest ends next month. Dave S. showed the 1-ounce silver bar that will be the prize for the winner of the contest.
 - Dave S. announced that a guess the price of gold contest will occur next. The contest will end on January 23, 2024, and is open to dues-paid members only.
5. New Business
 - CoinX will likely not be hosting a show during Summer Seminar this year. The club talked about doing a 1-day show during Summer Seminar on Friday or Saturday if CoinX does not occur. Either at the Eagles or another venue.
 - Dave S. brought up the idea of having a club want list, where members can share what items they need for their collection within the club.
 - The board came up with a plan for the meetings for this year, which include 6 speakers and a potential pizza party in July. There will be no YN night held this year.
 - Jerry F. announced the passing of Pat Fritz.
 - Doug L. encouraged members to volunteer at the ANA Library.
 - March will be our White Elephant sale – This is our #2 way to increase our treasury with sales generated from members purchases (1st is membership fees).
