TUESDAY, MAY 23 AT 6:30PM

This meeting was held at the Fraternal Order of Eagles.

2. Introduction of guests and new members:
 - 27 members, 9 guests
3. Secretary's Report:
 - Current membership is at 97 members.
 - New club members Giselle T. and Matt P. were voted in and new applying members Joe & Marjie S. will be voted on at the July meeting.
4. Treasurer's Report:
 - Balance as of the May meeting \$14,417.76 and as of the June meeting \$13,771.80.
 - Report was approved.
5. Old Business:
 - The 1st Springs Coin Show took place on Saturday, June 24 from 10:00 – 4:00 (9:30 early bird) at the FOE. 26 dealers with 39 tables. Approximately 33 came as early bird for \$5.
 - Rob Oberth with Round Table Trading generously donated all of the supplies from the previous Coins, Currency and Collectibles Show. This large donation includes table lamps, table covers, power strips, electrical cords, name badges and signage.
 - Thank you to Don at Falcon Coins for items on the free table and to Tom and Tricia W. for the bottled water.
6. New Business:
 - Bob C. purchased 60 gifts for the Christmas party. 40 in the \$15 range and 20 in the \$30 range. Tricia W. will plan the Secret Santa exchange and there will be prizes for the YN's as well.
 - At the July meeting we will have a pizza party and play BINGO.
7. Collector's Corner:
 - Chris L. – Chris L. put together a mystery jar with various assorted coins – Dollars, Kennedy's, cent rolls, etc. as a fund raiser for the club. Members will pay \$1 per guess or 6 guesses for \$5 as to how much money is in the jar. HINT: The value is between \$50-\$100.

The ANA's 2023 Young Numismatist of the Year is Kevin L—. At 17 years old, [he] has developed exceptional leadership skills. His ability to anticipate needs far in advance to get the job done earned him the position of second vice president for the Colorado Springs Coin Club (CSCC), and he also serves as the group's webmaster. He is a member of the Colorado Springs Numismatic Society (CSNS), and he wrote an article for The Elongated Collectors' *TEC News* that appeared in the October-December 2019 issue.

[He] is an ardent volunteer, having assisted at the 2017 World's Fair of Money®, the 2022 National Money Show®, the YN Benefit Auction at the ANA's Summer Seminar, and several local coin shows in Colorado Springs. He is a past exhibitor at the Colorado Springs Coin, Currency, and Collectibles Show and the National Money Show. He has also won several exhibit presentations at CSNS meetings.
