MINUTES of the OCTOBER 8, 2023 Meeting of the

COLORADO SPRINGS NUMISMATIC SOCIETY

The meeting was held at the Gold Hill Police Station Community Room and called to order by President Steve D. with 15 members and 1 guest in attendance.

Secretary's Report: Secretary's Report, was given which consists of the Minutes of the September 2023 meeting contained in the October 8, 2023 newsletter. Secretary's Report & the Treasurer's Report were given and a motion was made that both the Secretary & Treasurer Reports be accepted and both reports were approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

2024 Dues – CSNS is now collecting 2024 membership dues. Dues are \$10 for Individuals, \$5 for YNs (Young Numismatists are those under 18), and \$20 for a Family (all adults and children in the immediate family). George M. presented his quarterly bill for expenses (July, Aug. & Sept.). This amount totaled \$169.00 including door & membership prizes. Motion was made & approved by membership to reimburse George for this expense.

Regarding CSNS & CSCC co-hosting the ANA National Money show to be held at the Broadmoor Resort, March 14-16, 2024: A motion was made & approved for CSNS to co-host with CSCC for this event and Dave S. (President of CSCC) will be the Host Chairman for this show.

The Elks have a kitchenette area for preparing food, as well as several round tables with chairs. These accommodations are favorable to us for having the show in this location. Some discussion was made but we tabled the show sponsorship motion until the November meeting because no budget had been provided.

OCTOBER EXHIBITS

- 1) George M. showed the book "The Other Side of the Coin" by Edward C Rochette. He was more than just a member of both coin clubs having to help start the clubs in Colorado Springs many years ago. There is much numismatic material in this book relating to his writing of numismatic articles over the years.
- 2) Steve D. showed pictures from the Pittsburgh ANA and also displayed a number of mementos including ones having to do with the 50th anniversary of the Liberty Seated Coin Club. He also showed an 1852 dime (liberty seated, with drapery, with stars, prior to 1853 weight reduction) that was a big upgrade over the one previously in his type set. In fact, the 1852 was a plate coin in one of the older standard references.
- 3) Larry F. had a presentation about Walt Disney & displayed Disney memorabilia. He spoke about the Walt Disney gold medal that was presented to Mrs. Walt Disney on March 25, 1969 by President Richard Nixon. In 1968, the Congress of the United States, by reason, of a joint resolution decided to honor Walt Disney with a gold Commemorative medal for his service through so many years, not only to the people of the United States, but to people around the world. Walt Disney pioneered motion pictures, cartoons, produced spectacular feature films and created fascinating nature studies bringing joy and pleasure to children of all ages. The U.S. Congress also sanctioned the minting of 100,000 replicas of the medal in bronze. Congress specified that these special medals be made available & distributed by California Institute of Art. Larry displayed one of the bronze medals of Walt Disney with the reverse of Mickey Mouse.
