March Program: ANA Coin Week Activity (“ Discover the Past, Envision the Future “) Seven coin club members, led by Terry C. participated in the ANA Club Trivia Challenge. The answers to the Trivia Challenge were compiled and will be sent to the ANA to be entered into the Coin Week contest. The club members who participated in the Trivia Challenge will be eligible for one of 3 prizes of equal value in a drawing to be held at the Holiday Party in December. If the coin club were to win any of the prizes given out by the ANA for the Club Trivia Challenge those prizes will also be passed on to participating club members at the December prize drawing. March YN Activity: CSCC member, Jerry F. awarded a complete current set of U.S. National Park Quarters, a coin folder for the quarters, and cotton gloves to use when putting the coins into the folder to YN; Eve B. Eve will display the U.S. National Park folder with the inserted coins and give a 2 - 3 minute presentation about her favorite national park at this month's (April 23rd) coin club meeting. CSCC Special Event: Coin club members met at the ANA on Tuesday, April 9th for a special presentation by ANA Museum Curator / Director Doug Mudd. Coin club members were able to learn about and handle several rare coins including: two 1804 dollars (6 known) that were actually minted in 1835 as presentation pieces; a 1933 MS 64 Eagle (25 or so known, almost all of the 312,000 gold coins that were minted were melted down) ; a 25% to 30% off strike Morgan (O) silver dollar (a very rare error coin); a Massachusetts Oak Tree Shilling (1652); a Mexican 3 real (1536 - 1538) - one of the first coins struck in the New World by the Spanish; and traditional money in the form of 2 small YAP stones made of limestone. **Thank You, Jerry** for arranging this special event for CSCC members.
