Dan U. shared 5 coins he received from the bank and in change: 3 of the 2020 America the Beautiful® quarters (*American Samoa, US Virgin Islands, Vermont*); 2 non-circulating dollar coins (2019 American Innovation, *Polio Vaccine*; 2020 Native American, *Elizabeth Peratrovich*.)

Richard J. Related his frustrating experience trying to acquire the End of World War II 75th Anniversary gold coin and silver medal from the U.S. Mint. Sales were online and the gold coins sold out in 6 minutes, silver medals in 90 minutes. The rarity of these coins, especially the gold coin with a mintage of 1945, created the highest traffic in mint website history and caused the site to crash. Richard's persistence was rewarded with a confirmed order for a silver medal.
