MINUTES of the NOVEMBER 12, 2023 Meeting of the
COLORADO SPRINGS NUMISMATIC SOCIETY

The meeting was held at the Gold Hill Police Station Community Room and called to order by President Steve D. with 16 members present and no guests in attendance.

Secretary's Report: Secretary's Report, was given which consists of the Minutes of the October 2023 meeting contained in the November 12, 2023 newsletter. Secretary's Report & the Treasurer's Report were given and a motion was made that both the Secretary & Treasurer Reports be accepted and both reports were approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

2024 Dues – CSNS is now collecting 2024 membership dues.

Dues are \$10 for Individuals, \$5 for YNs (Young Numismatists are those under 18), and \$20 for a Family (all adults and children in the immediate family). Christmas Party (CSNS/CSCC) was held December 14 at the Golden Corral. CSNS hosted it for 2023. Attendance was 40-45 members. Each member received a gift, including YN's & children. The "Secret Santa" which was planned by Tricia W. added to the enjoyment of everyone, making our Christmas party a great success.

CSNS & CSCC will be co-hosting the ANA National Money show to be held at the Broadmoor Resort, March 14-16, 2024: A table for the two clubs to share, will be provided by the ANA. Please keep in mind that volunteers will be needed not only for the club table but also throughout the ANA show.

Springs Coin Show will be held June 21-22, 2024 at the Elks Lodge on N. Nevada Ave. There had been, previously, some discussion made about the club sponsorship (CSNS & CSCC). This issue was tabled until the November meeting because no budget had been provided; however, after a bit more discussion, a motion was made and membership approved for CSNS to co-sponsor the Springs Coin Show with CSCC.

CSNS Constitution (By Laws). Discussion on this topic was made that perhaps some

parts of it will need to be re-addressed & maybe some changes to be made to it at some time later on.

During our October meeting, a club member inquired whether the club should put some of the club's money into a short term CD (Certificate of Deposit). At the November meeting, Treasurer was still continuing to get some information about the club's ability to put some money into a CD.

NEW BUSINESS

Note: CSCC Election of Officers was held November 28th. Re-elected was Dave S. for President, Steve D. (Vice-President) & Barbara (Treasurer). Newly elected was Scott S. (2nd VP), and Akio (Secretary).

NOVEMBER EXHIBITS

- 1) Larry F. gave a presentation on the 60th anniversary of President John F. Kennedy's assassination 11/22/63. Displayed were items of memorabilia connected to John F. Kennedy Some of which were: an inaugural Kennedy medal, dated 1/20/61, a 2015 Presidential Kennedy dollar, a lapel pin PT 109, a 1980 half & token representing the Kennedy / Nixon debate.
- 2) Steve D. presented an 1868 S eagle (\$10 gold piece). He told of a standards change in mid-1873 (promising to tell more about the change itself at a future meeting) and how in the aftermath of the Civil War gold coinage was scarce. Since there was a change in 1866 to the "With Motto" (In God We Trust) variety, the \$5, \$10, and \$20 have three very difficult subtypes from 1866 to mid-1873. In fact the 1868 S eagle is not known in uncirculated grades at all. Steve's example is in AU 55.
- 3) Tom W. presentation & exhibit was about Air Force Football ...the 2022 Commander-in-Chief Trophy Championship. The medal (front) showed "21st CIC Victory" and on the back (" AF Football ") The score was AF 13, Navy 10.
